

COVID-19 PCR TESTING

CDC testing guidance on symptoms:

- Physicians may order a COVID-19 test based on this CDC testing guidance on symptoms:
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache, new loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- Have been in close contact (less than 6 feet for 15 minutes) with someone who tested positive for COVID-19.
- Attended a gathering of more than 10 people who did not wear masks or participate in social distancing.
- Work or live in a nursing home.
- Are in an essential worker category exposing you to a lot of people.
- You have had known or suspected exposure to someone with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
